The Case for Israel by Alan Dershowitz

The 77-minute film presents evidence from leading historians, analysts, legal experts and leaders on both sides of the political spectrum to make the definitive case for Israel's legitimacy and right to self-defence.

Dershowitz argues forcefully that real peace in the Middle East can only occur when the Palestinians, Arabs and their allies finally value the creation of a Palestinian state more than they oppose the presence of a Jewish state. Through incisive conversations with 28 commentators—ranging from Foreign Minister Tzipi Livni, Ambassador Dennis Ross and former Israel Supreme Court President Aharon Barak to Opposition Leader Benjamin Netanyahu and senior analysts Caroline Glick and Natan Sharansky—Dershowitz refutes deeply entrenched misconceptions about Israel's history, Jewish claims to a homeland, individual rights under Israel's democratic system of government, the security fence, and military conduct in the face of terrorist attacks.
