Services for Yom Tov are according to children's age and not school year. This will ensure that your children are familiar with the services and prayers that are said over the Yom Tov period and assist those taking the services.

Group 1: 4 years old and under

Group 2: 5 – 6 years old

Group 3: 7 – 8 years old

Group 4: 9 – 11 years old

Please help to avoid overcrowding by limiting the number of adults that attend each service per family.

The Marquee for **group 1** is situated in the rear playground with **orange** signs indicating its location. Signs to the classrooms will be colour coded in **blue** for **group 2** and **green** for **group 3**. Access to the library for **group 4** is via the synagogue staircase and will be indicated in **red**. Stewards will direct children to the appropriate service.

There are gazebos behind the security hut for pushchairs.

Parents should always know where their children are in the building and ensure that they do not run around and cause a disturbance.

From Shabbat Bereshit (29th October) children should go to services according to their current school year (Pre school & Nursery, Reception & Year 1, Years 2 & 3, Years 4, 5 & 6).

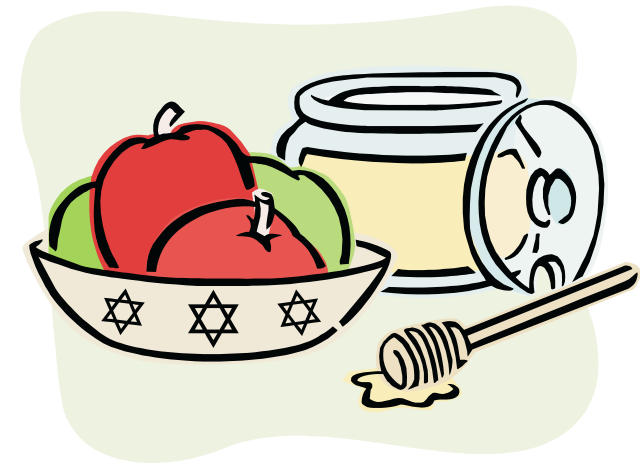
